The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Environmental Justice Grants

Availability of \$100 million under TWO environmental justice programs:

<u>The Environmental Justice Collaborative Problem-Solving Program (EJCPS) Cooperative Agreement Program</u> will provide \$30 million to community-based nonprofit organizations with projects that address public health or environmental issues in their local communities.
