California State University Dominguez Hills



GREENLINE HOME PROGRAM: GRANTS FOR FIRST-TIME HOMEBUYERS

The Department of Consumer and Business Affairs and the LA County Center for Financial Empowerment have launched the County of Los Angeles Greenline Home Program which aims to tackle the legacy of redlining. The goal is to empower and uplift economically marginalized communities. \$35,000 grants will be available for first-time homebuyers with low to moderate income and living in high-need to highest-need areas of Los Angeles County. 
A few weeks ago, the LACDA announced its new Home Ownership Program, HOP120. The loans will assist moderate-income homebuyers earning 120% of the Area Median Income for Los Angeles County in the purchase of their first home. HOP120 provides a second mortgage loan for first-time homebuyers with assistance up to \$85,000, or 20% of the purchase price, whichever is less. The loan provides down payment and/or closing cost assistance and is secured with a Deed of Trust and Promissory Note. Eligible properties must be in unincorporated Los Angeles County or participating cities.

To apply for the Program, applicants must use an LACDA-approved participating lender who will submit the application on their behalf. For more details on HOP 120, <u>click here</u>.


DPSS LAUNCHES NEW LGBTQ+ RESOURCE PAGE
