Changes to You EDD Debit Card Starting in 2024


Beginning February 15th, anyone receiving EDD benefits by debit card will start receiving payments to their new Money Network prepaid debit card.

FREE INFANT HEALTH SERVICES IN THE SOUTH BAY AND NEARBY COMMUNITIES

African American women disproportionately give birth to infants, who are born prematurely or die before their first birthday. Black Infant Health supports women who identify as African American, who are 30 weeks pregnant or

less, need postpartum assistance up to 6 months, and 18 years of age or older.

The program offers case management, social support, life planning, sister circle groups, and baby support materials.
