BRYAN'S BILLS

I am <u>coauthoring SCA 10</u>, the amendment to the State constitution securing Reproductive Freedom, which is now on the November ballot.

We have 9 bills making their way through the Senate: <u>AB 1685</u>, <u>AB 1686</u>, <u>AB 1735</u>, <u>AB 1816</u>, <u>AB 1823</u>, <u>AB 1913</u>, <u>AB 2159</u>, <u>AB 2419</u>, and <u>AB 2425</u>.

The Select Committee on Poverty and Economic Inclusion held a <u>rally and special inaugural hearing</u>.

July 1st is the last day for policy committees to consider bills. The Assembly will take their Summer recess from July 1 to August 1.

Workers must be paid \$15.96 per hour

Beginning July 1, <u>workers</u> who work at least two hours a week in the <u>unincorporated areas of LA County</u>, must be paid at least \$15.96 an hour.

Businesses in unincorporated LA County are also required to post both the primary Official Notice and the 2022 supplemental posting in a conspicuous place at the workplace or jobsite.

DCBA's Wage Enforcement counselors can help of the student business owners remain in compliance with the minimum wage and other worker protection ordinances. Workers can also report suspected violations of the minimum of the student at 6 AM.

Car-Free Weekends on Main Street

On March 28, 2022, the City Council approved a plan to make Main Street car-free every weekend. Public Works Department staff, in coordination with the Fire and Police Departments, conducted a successful test closure from June 17 – June 20.

Beginning June 24, 2022, Main Street between Culver Boulevard and the City Limit will become car-free every weekend. Water-filled barricades will be placed at both ends of the street each Friday at 6 PM until the following Monday at 6 AM.

All businesses will remain open! Consider walking, biking, scooting or taking a <u>Culver CityBus</u> to Main Street. If you are arriving by car, please note that on-street parking on Main Street will be prohibited during that time, however the downtown parking structures will be open.

California Mortgage Relief Program Expansion



California's housing department announced an expansion of its federally funded mortgage relief program, a move that could help tens of thousands more residents keep a roof over their heads. Under the loosened eligibility requirements, homeowners earning at or below 150% of their county's area median income can now apply for relief of as much as \$80,000 if they missed at least two payments prior to June 30, 2022, and are currently delinquent. Meanwhile, Californians who own their home outright or have up-to-date mortgage payments can receive as much as \$20,000 to cover overdue property taxes if they missed at least one payment prior to May 31, 2022.


