EPA Community Change Grants

Approximately \$2 billion dollars in Inflation Reduction Act funds have been announced in environmental and climate justice activities to benefit disadvantaged communities through projects that reduce pollution, increase community climate resilience, and build community capacity to address environmental and climate justice challenges. Deadline to apply is November 21, 2024. Learn More

California Advanced Services Fund (CASF) Adoption Account

The Broadband Adoption Account provides grants to increase publicly available or after-school broadband access and digital inclusion, such as grants for digital literacy training programs and public education to communities with limited broadband adoption. Application cycle deadline: July 1, 2024. <u>Apply</u>

SoCal Climate Champions Grant

Funded by SoCalGas and managed by DoGoodery, the SoCal Climate Champions Grant invests up to \$400,000 annually in programs, projects, and research that address community climate solutions in Southern California. This grant program is designed to invest in a future with net-zero emissions through clean, safe, and innovative ideas that put people and communities first. Grant Opportunity for the Expansion of Family Resource Centers, 2022-2025

Grantees will increase activities, supports, and services especially for families and communities that have been historically underserved, marginalized, and adversely affected by persistent poverty and other stressors, including Black, brown, indigenous, migrant, and LGBTQ+ children and families, and rural communities. Grants for Non-Profits to Acquire Vacant Property in LA County

The Department of Economic Opportunity will be providing recoverable grants ranging between \$500k to \$2M to non-profit organizations in designated communities that are looking to acquire a vacant or abandoned land or building. Grants will be available this spring. Learn more
