LA County Economic Opportunity Grants Program

EOG offers \$54+ million in grant awards, technical assistance, and other County services to help businesses recover, stabilize, and grow! Grants will be available over multiple rounds starting in <u>January 2023</u>. <u>Sign up today</u> for additional information and next steps!

The <u>PROTECT Program</u> aims to fund projects that improve the resilience of surface transportation systems, such as highways, public transportation, ports, and intercity passenger rail, in response to the climate crisis. The program, administered by the U.S. Department of Administration (USDOT), has a funding allocation of up to \$848 million for the fiscal years 2022 and 2023 available for:

- Planning Grants
- Resilience Improvement Grants
- Community Resilience and Evacuation Route Grants
- At-Risk Coastal Infrastructure Grants
