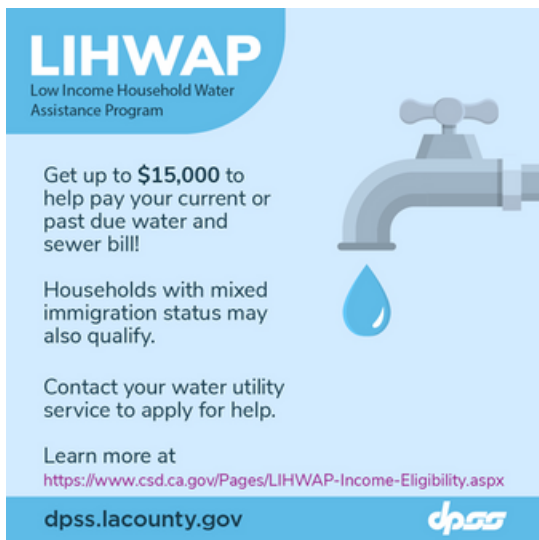

CALIFORNIANS WITH PAST DUE WATER BILLS CAN GET HELP WITH LIHWAP

Low-income Los Angeles County residents, who are behind on water bill payments, may seek assistance through the [Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program](https://www.csd.ca.gov/Pages/LIHWAP-Income-Eligibility.aspx) (LIHWAP). The federally funded program will be extended through March 2024 while eligible applicants and households may receive up to \$15,000 in assistance with no impact to other benefits or public charge determinations. Stay Healthy Over the Holidays

This winter at least 1 dose of the new COVID-19 vaccine, which became available in mid-September, is recommended for everyone 6 months and older. It is designed to protect against virus strains circulating now and help boost your immunity, which diminishes over time.

I'M OVER 65. WHAT VACCINES SHOULD I GET?

Adults, ages 65 and older, remain at higher risk of severe illness, hospitalization and death from respiratory viruses. To reduce those risks experts recommend an updated COVID-19, Flu, and RSV vaccine.

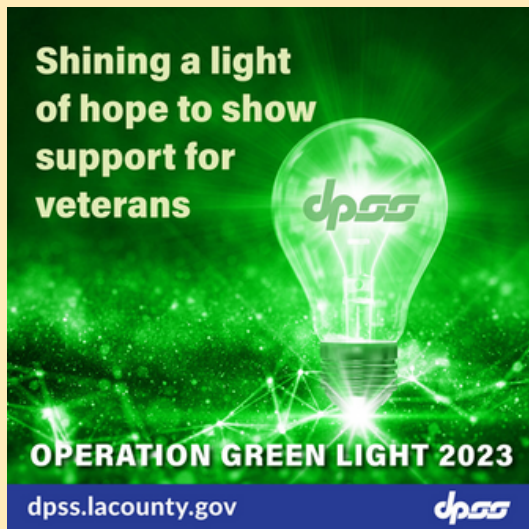


Don't Forget to Travel Green

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistant program is recruiting volunteers for the upcoming tax season. Learn a new skill while helping others. Free training is available.



What is the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance?

The VITA program is an IRS-sponsored program that helps low-income families file basic tax returns with the help from trained and certified volunteers.

How do I get involved?

No experience is required and free training is available.

- Sign-up online at freetaxprepla.org.
- Attend an Information Session & ask questions.
- Free training resources are available on the web.
- Access to free tax software and certification tests.
- Not all volunteers prepare taxes. Many volunteer positions are available.



INFO SESSIONS & TRAINING

First time volunteers should expect to train about 10-15 hours. All tests and tax software are provided for free.



Get Certified

All volunteers complete two short and simple tests: Standards of Conduct & Intake and Interviewing. Tax preparers may complete Basic or Advance level taxes. All tests are open book and support is available.

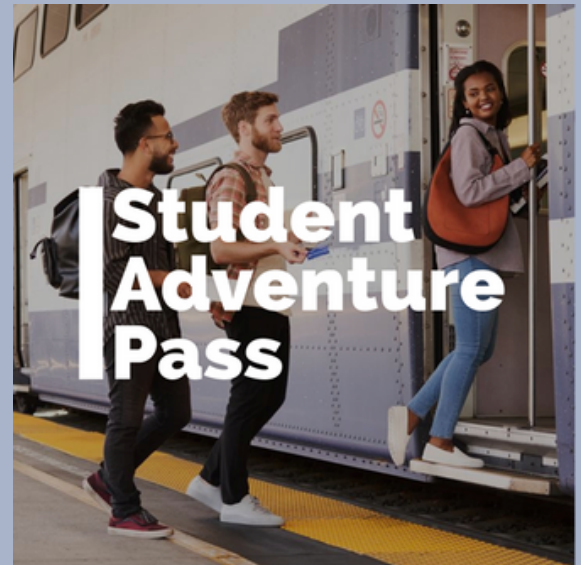
