


Youth Development Network Public Workgroup

\$125M for Consumer Electronics Battery Recycling, Reprocessing, and Battery Collection

This program aims to support the recycling of consumer electronics batteries and battery-containing devices to bolster the domestic critical material supply chain for EV batteries. Concept papers are due on August 17, 2023. Full applications are due November 29, 2023. Learn more.
