Reconnecting Communities Pilot (RCP) Program Grants

States, counties, cities, tribal governments, and nonprofits. The RCP program will fund projects that reconnect communities by removing, retrofitting, or mitigating infrastructure facilities that have created mobility and economic barriers. \$195 million is available in FY 22 for planning or capital construction grants. Applications are due Thursday, October 13, 2022.
